

ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS

The law determines compulsory school age begins at the start of the term following a child's fifth birthday.

The decision about when to start your child at school is yours. Parents can request that the date their child is admitted to the school is deferred until later in the school year or until the child reaches compulsory school age in that school year.

We recommend that you discuss the options with your early years provider or the school if you have any concerns regarding the readiness of your child to start in September or whether to accept a full-time or part-time school place.

If you notify on the acceptance form that you wish to defer your child's place until later in the school year or if you wish your child to attend on a part-time basis and you subsequently decide that your child is ready to attend school, then you can discuss a mutually convenient start date with the Head of EYFS or the Headteacher. We would also recommend that you advise your early years setting of your decision.

The school will advise you on the part time options available.

Transfer to Secondary School

As soon as your child starts in Year 6, you will receive full information about the choices you have for secondary school.

Most of our children transfer to 'The Holt School' (girls), The Forest School (boys) and Emmbrook School (mixed). We have been closely linked with these schools but there are many other options including grammar and denominational schools.

An admissions booklet is available from Wokingham Borough Council who co-ordinate all admissions for Local Authority Maintained Schools.
