

Year 6 Snow Day Activities

Maths:

- Investigate how many different examples you can come up with where we use and talk about fractions, decimals and percentages in everyday life.
- Select three jobs and write about how that career would involve needing to know and understand the equivalence between fractions, decimals and percentages.
- Create a colourful poster using pictures and diagrams to explain the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages for your class's Working Wall.
- Continue to practise your multiplication and division facts.

English:

You have two options: the first relating to Ancient Greek myths and the second focusing on your independent creative writing.

- Create and draw a mythical beast that could have appeared in an Ancient Greek myth. Write a descriptive paragraph of it moving around in its lair – show, don't tell, what the essence of its character is in what it does. Make sure your writing engages the reader, drawing on all their senses.
- Write a short summary of *Theseus and the Minotaur* in fewer than fifty words.
- Work on your 500 word story.
