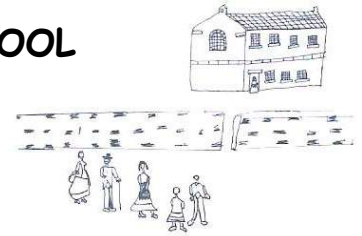

### Red Class Swimming - starting Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May

Red Class children will have 10 consecutive lessons starting on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May. Each lesson is 45mins. Red Class will start their swim lesson at 12.50pm therefore ALL children will need a PACKED LUNCH on swim days as they will eat early before departing (school packed lunches can be ordered). Children need swimming costume & towel (goggles are optional but a swim hat is required to be worn if your child has long hair). We do have a small stock of swim hats and goggles if needed. A contribution of £3.00 per child per lesson is requested which can be paid weekly or in total (£30.00). Children are permitted to wear a tracksuit (navy) on swim days for ease of changing or school uniform. We regret that due to ever tightening budgets that children absent from a lesson will still need to cover the cost and would request that everyone pays a contribution.
