Parent Consultation sign up

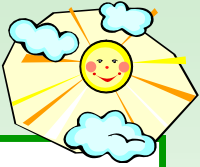

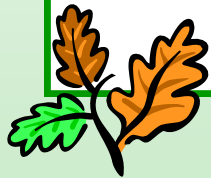

In the Autumn Term

- Six Weeks In for all new parents to meet the teachers, ask questions and take the opportunity to find out more about the school.
- Parent Consultations with children attending. At this meeting all families are given the National Curriculum attainment that their child is working at.
- Foundation Stage have a review with parents on how their child is settling in and the next steps.
- Families are given their child's reading and spelling ages (Years 2—6).
- Pupil Profile Reports are verbally given, copies available on request.
- Foundation Stage have a 'Celebration of Learning' afternoon.



In the Spring Term

- Parent Consultations with children attending.
- All families are given National Curriculum attainment and clear targets for improvement.
- Families with Foundation Stage pupils are given developmental stages of the Foundation Stage curriculum.
- Pupil Profile written report, copies given on attendance at the Consultations.
- Foundation Stage have a 'Celebration of Learning' afternoon.



In the Summer Term

- School Annual written report stating the National Curriculum standards achieved or the goals achieved within the Foundation Stage curriculum.
- Annual Open Evening to view the work of the whole school and to share the successes of our children.
