Focused priorities for FSM improvement and Closing the Gap

Focused priority 1

Provide an enriched curriculum for the children in order to raise aspirations, engagement in the curriculum and enrich learning opportunities.

- Educational resources for each key stage including enhanced ICT resources and capital **£18.000**
- Music lessons and visits (e.g. Barnstondale) including transport **£6.000**
- Additional Writing support materials **£2.000**

Focused priority 2

Improvements in pastoral/behaviour support/Motivation

- Attendance including incentives **£5.000**
- Additional Teaching Assistants for clubs, Breakfast club and support **£27.262**
- Salaries **£19.606**
- Healthy eating support **£2.200**
- Nurture/Behaviour **£16.023**
- Outdoor provision enhanced **£20.000**
- Global/Eco **£2.000**

Focused priority 3

Reduced barriers to learning

- Speech and Language Therapist - half day a week **£4.958**
- Inclusion manager and support salaries **£28.884**
- Beanstalk Readers **£2.000**
- Improving L&T through additional bought in support (EYFS) and KS1 **£3.000**
- Specialist SEN resources **£5.000**

To be reviewed Autumn 2014

In Autumn 2014 £158,822 was re-allocated to Pupil Premium and all codes re-adjusted.

Salaries for staffing remained - Resources and outdoor area reduced.
