Lanner Parish Council would like to advise all families visiting the Lanner Moor Playing Field that following prolonged and persistent vandalism new doors have been fitted to the toilets. This will include a charge of 20 pence for the use of the facilities. It was hoped that notice of this could have been given but further damage this week has necessitated the charge being introduced with immediate effect.

This is a nominal charge and if the facilities are protected it is hoped that in the longer-term improvements can be made. Please remember to take change with you when visiting the Playing Field.

Council sincerely hopes that by securing the toilets and preventing open access to those wishing to commit acts of vandalism and anti-social behaviour the facilities can be improved and retained.
