Dear Parent and Carers,

I hope you are all well and safe. Firstly, a genuine thank you for your amazing efforts and support this week. I know so many of you have taken extra precautions, and are continuing to do so, and have booked PCR tests for yourselves or your child. Despite these incredibly challenging conditions, knowing that you are working alongside us as a team is incredibly reassuring for us all. So thank you from myself and all the staff here.

COVID19: No news this week, other than we are fully aware of the extraordinarily high numbers of positive cases in our local community. All measures remain in place at school, and we are continuing to watch and monitor government guidelines.

Reading: As you know, we base our entire curriculum around reading and promote the love of reading as much as we can. Recent assessments have shown fantastic results in our reading across the entire school. We have 100% of our children passing the phonics screening check by the end of KS1, with more and more of our younger children accessing a wider range of books to read and our older children (based on teacher assessment and past SATs papers) making fantastic progress too. Approximately 88-90% of the Y6 children achieving age related expectation in reading and 30% achieving greater depth. All of this, despite two lock-downs!! To say I am proud of all the children and staff, has to be the understatement of the year. In addition, a proportion of this success has to be placed firmly with yourselves. Your hard work and commitment to home learning ensured a smooth transition back to school life and has really helped your child continue to make good progress. I am just delighted that our year 6 children are very well placed to make a smooth and successful transition into their next phase of education.

That is all from me this week. Please stay safe and take care.

Well Done


