Dear Parents/carers

As I am sure you are well aware the parking at Lanner school, like many schools, is a very tricky one. There is no quick fix to this problem - however we are working to try and ease some of the issues.

This week we have allocated a member of staff to be on the school gate from 8.30a.m until 9.00a.m every day. This is a precautionary measure to ensure the safety of children and adults walking into the school grounds. Please note - this adult or any other member of staff will not be responsible for directing traffic or assisting vehicles in anyway, but solely there to assist the childrens' safety.

We are in the initial stages of implementing a walking bus - again to alleviate some of the pressure of the vehicles entering the grounds.

If only 10 children took up this offer of a walking - that would still be 10 less vehicles entering the grounds in the morning. Not to mention the health benefits of walking to school. I will keep you informed of any updates regarding this and I would really appreciate any comments or suggestions from yourselves. If anyone is interested in volunteering to help with a walking bus or assisting our staff on the school gate in the morning please could you give your details to the office. We would love to hear from you and I am confident that together we will continue to improve the parking at Lanner. Thank you all for dealing with this situation in a professional and caring manner. On the mornings I have been out on duty, I have seen nothing but cooperation and consideration from parents.
