Dear Parent and Carers,

What a week. We have been blessed with gorgeous weather for our sports and health week and I hope the children have enjoyed it as much as the staff have. I had the pleasure of teaching every single child in the school this week, and what a pleasure it was. Admittedly, it was football so it was not too challenging, but I was so glad to get to spend some time with ALL the children. Seeing them learn, play and grow together was fascinating. To see the journey that they embark on from Nursery through to Year 6 was truly a privilege for me. Needless to say, the children's behaviour was impeccable (also backed up by some of our outdoor sports coaches, who commented on how the children at Lanner were the best behaved and mannered that they had taught all year). The past week was a personal reminder for me why I became a teacher in the first place. These are precious years and I believe we are all duty bound to make them as special, valuable and enjoyable for these young children as best we can. So a big well done to ALL the children and staff. It has been lovely.

COVID19: There is a lot of information to digest at the moment with regards to bubbles and schools etc. At present, as it stands, August the 16th will see the removal of bubbles in schools. This also means that whole classes will not have to isolate if there is a positive case within the bubble - when we return in September. In addition, from July 19th onwards, schools will no longer be responsible for track and trace. **However, there will be no changes here at Lanner until we break up for the summer holidays. We will continue to operate in bubbles and we will continue to notify parents of any positive cases within their bubbles for 48 hours after we break up.** I do not want to speculate too much about September because I believe no one really knows what things will look

like in September. I intend writing to you all towards the end of August with updates and I pray that things will be moving in the right direction, but let's just wait and see.
