Summer Library Reading Challenge

Carn Brea Leisure Centre Public Consultation

SLC is a leading sports and leisure consultancy that has been commissioned to undertake a study which will review the potential future investment opportunities at Carn Brea Leisure Centre. We are looking at how the Trust can improve the way it services the needs of the local community - both those people that are active but also those that may not as active as they would like to be. SLC is conducting an important public consultation exercise to find out what the local community would like to see provided at the centre and also about the

barriers and challenges local people face regarding physical activity and sport. Of particular importance is ensuring that hard to reach groups of people have an opportunity to have their say about the future of leisure facilities in their area. SLC would like a strong response from a cross-section of the local community including children and young people and also from parents. There are two surveys - one for those that already use Can Brea Leisure Centre and one for those who do not.
