If your child has a no booking, they will not necessarily have their first choice of meal and are made to wait until all other booked children have been fed.

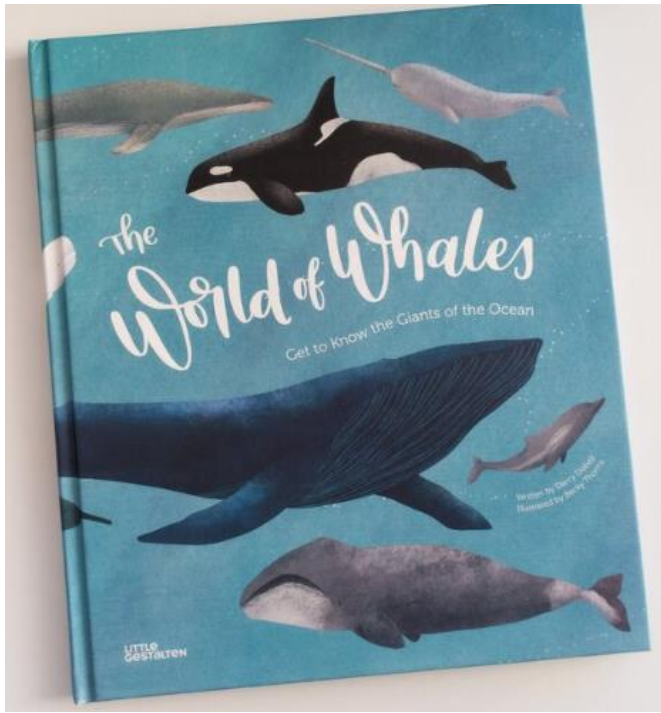
Bookings can be made up until 9am on the day, any issues please contact the Office.
