
## Blast Club

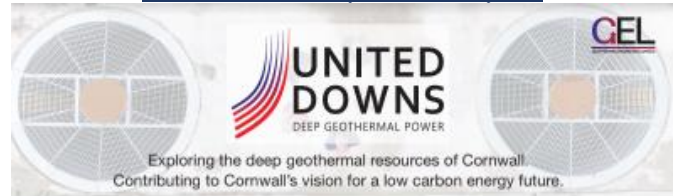
