Dear Parents and Carers

As many of you will know, our curriculum in school changed in September 2014. The 'ICT' aspect of the curriculum changed to 'Computing'. Although we taught e-safety as part of our ICT sessions, this is now a requirement of the new Computing curriculum.

At KS1 we are required to teach children to:

- ♦ *use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private; identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content or contact on the internet or other online technologies.*

At KS2 we are required to teach children to:

- ♦ *use technology safely, respectfully and responsibly; recognise acceptable / unacceptable behaviour; identify a range of ways to report concerns about content and contact.*

Part of our role in school is to guide children to make sensible choices about how they use the wide range of technologies which are available to them at home as well as at school. With this in mind, we have compiled some information for parents which we hope you will find useful.
