

United Downs Deep Geothermal Power
Project Drop-In on Monday 18th February 2pm
- 4pm

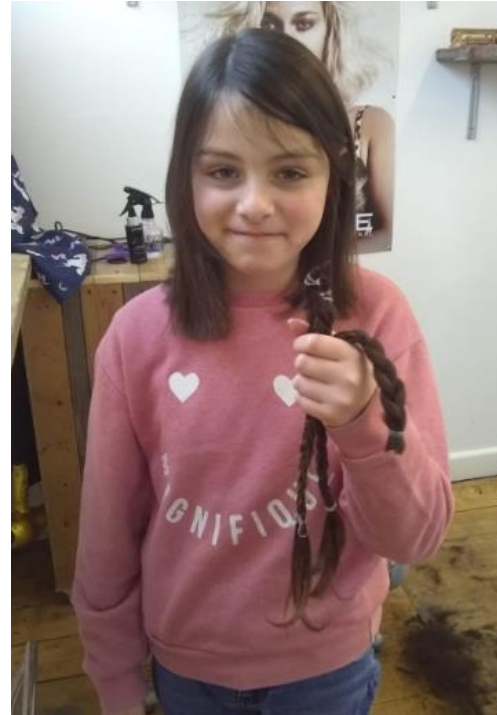
Visit the United Downs Deep Geothermal Power (UDDGP) project site in half term on Monday 18th February any time between 2pm - 4pm to talk to members of the project team, browse the information panels, watch educational and project films, get up close to two of the used drill bits and view the 52m high drilling rig from the viewing platform.

Drop-In sessions are free and suitable for all the family with colouring pages and an interesting facts trail. Under 18s must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. Visitor access is on foot through gate B and parking is available at gate C, which is a short walk from the drilling site.

GEL **UNITED DOWNS**
Geothermal Engineering Limited (GEL) has secured funding of £10.6 million from the European Regional Development Fund, £2.4 million from Cornwall Council and £5 million from private investors, to explore the geothermal resources deep beneath Cornwall.

This funding will allow GEL to drill two deep geothermal wells from its site within the United Downs Industrial Estate and build a 1MW - 3MW pilot power plant to demonstrate the technical and commercial viability of supplying both electricity and heat.
