Borrow Box Books

As you know, we are very keen for the children at Lanner to develop a lifelong love of reading. We have lots of great books in the school library but are also aware that some children like to read their own books at home. Our local libraries are a fantastic source of books, and regularly have newly published books available to borrow as well as old favourites. They also now have an app from which you can download ebooks, or audio books, onto a phone or tablet to read or listen to. The app, called 'Borrow Box', provides access to books for children as well as adults and works on a similar system to the library where you can 'borrow' a book for a period of time.
