This week we have been reading the story of *The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch*. We have been making lighthouses in the Creative Area and have made sandwiches for Mr Grinling, labelling our ingredients. We also made real jam sandwiches this week, which were delicious! We used these to practise how to write instructions.

In Literacy we have used sandwich shaped paper to write recipes for our sandwiches. We have learnt to read and write lots of CVCC words, for example: sent, went, pond, jump and some new tricky words, including some, come, little, like and have. We are continuing to practise forming all our letters correctly and using full stops and capital letters.

In Maths we have been learning all about the number 20, different ways we can make it and using it to solve problems. We have been counting in 5s and 10s and solving problems including how many groups of 5 make 20.
