This week we have been continuing to read about mermaids. We have been writing our own sentences and stories. In Letters and Sounds, we have re-visited ear, ure and air and have learnt two new tricky words- *have* and *like*. We have been practising writing Consonant, Vowel, Consonant, Consonant words (CVCC words) e.g. damp, tent and using these in our sentence writing.

In Maths we have been learning to halve an amount, e.g. half of 10. We have linked this to solving problems involving halving and doubling. We found out that when we halve a number, it gets smaller. We also found that not all numbers of objects can be halved equally and these are called *odd* numbers.

We are all very excited that we have some sunflowers to grow. It is a group challenge from Mrs Morris and we have been talking about the best place for plants to grow and what they will need.

- Can you halve some items at home or in your garden? Find a set number of items and split them into two groups so there are equal amounts in each group.
- Can you use one of the words – **they, all, into, are** - in a sentence?
