Our Lottery is up and running!

It costs just £1 per week, with a weekly Saturday draw and the chance to win a £25K jackpot. **Buy a ticket now for the draw on November 3rd!**

We have, at the time of writing, sold over 60 tickets. This would generate an amazing £1268 a year for school funds – if we manage to sell 100 tickets a week this would give school an income of over £2000 a year and a weekly prize of around £35 with great odds of 1 in 100 chance of winning! That beats the National Lottery hands down.

This is an easy way to support our school and to raise funds that will go towards providing the exciting extras in school for your own children.
