## SATS

Our Y6 have now completed their SATS. We are very proud of them all. Results will be available on July 10<sup>th</sup> –we will tell the children their marks individually in the morning and parents will receive a letter from school on the day.

Y2 have also finished their tests and performed really well. Y2 final scores are based on teacher assessment. These will be shared on the children's school report which will be sent out next half term.

## School Meals

We have now opened a 'Deli bar' at lunchtime. Children have the option of a range of bread, including rolls, wraps and baguettes along with 2 fillings, such as egg, ham, tuna and chicken. There is also unlimited salad, a dessert and a cold drink.

School meals are free for children in Reception – Year 1 and £2.30 for children in Year 3 – Year 6. All payments for meals is by Parent Pay.

There will be a children's entertainer, along with dancing and games, followed by a hotdog and treats supper. All inclusive tickets are £5 per child and are on sale now from the office.

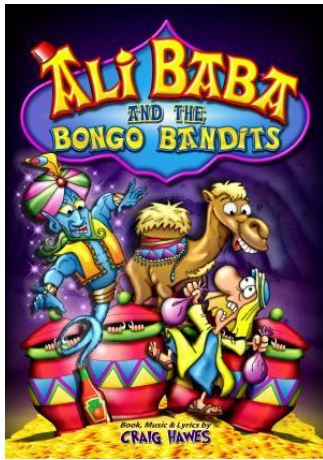
## Reception Graduation
