Meanwhile, we are collecting non-perishable items, these can be food or toiletries, to donate to local foodbanks.

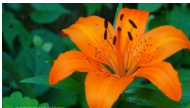
Our children welcome any opportunity to share and experience the joy of giving. Any donations are very gratefully received and should be taken to your child's classroom.
