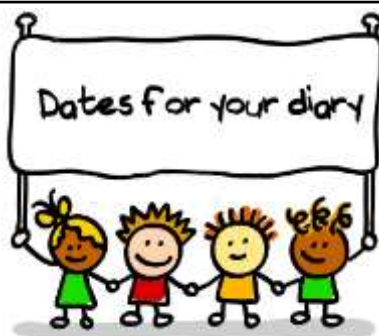
## **Inspirational Careers**
