Thank you to all parents for your support of the school. The children as always were wonderful; and we are all very proud of them. Under the new inspection regime all inspections are two days, and we only know the outcome on publication.

Last week we celebrated National Poetry day. The Drama club presented some lovely poems in KS2 assembly, and the children all enjoyed exploring poems in class. On Monday our new School and Eco Councils held their first meeting of the year and shared ideas and thoughts with the staff (Sports Council meet next month). Then yesterday Y5 visited the Space Centre. They had a wonderful day and were really inspired in their learning.

Next week is currently looking quite quiet. I can only hope it remains so!

Our annual celebration of Harvest is on Wednesday 23rd October at 9:45am. This will be a very short assembly this year, to which parents are invited. For Health and Safety reasons we can only accommodate 70 parents. Please be understanding that this is a legal limit and places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. If you would like to join with the children for the short assembly please drop a note into the school office on Monday 14th October. Thank you. We will be asking the children for voluntary monetary donations which will be divided equally between the local food bank and the Tree Aid 'Great Green Wall' campaign.

Also that week, Tuesday 22nd and Thursday 24th October are our autumn term Parent Consultation Meetings. We look forward to seeing you then. Please note appointments are booked electronically via your e-schools account. The book fair will also be available as usual.

On Thursday 24th the PTA are holding a cake sale after school; then on Friday 25th the children are invited to attend school in Halloween themed dress down (no large props or 'blood' please for safety reasons) for a donation to PTA funds. The new long term project for which the PTA are now fundraising is a roof for part of the playground to make covered space available for board games, table based play etc. We are very excited about this proposed addition to the school.
