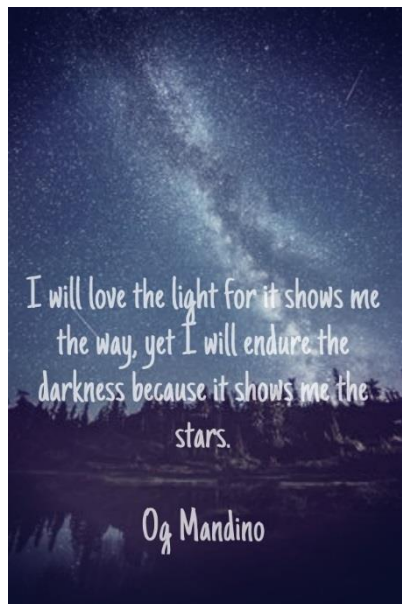
Liturgy in School
