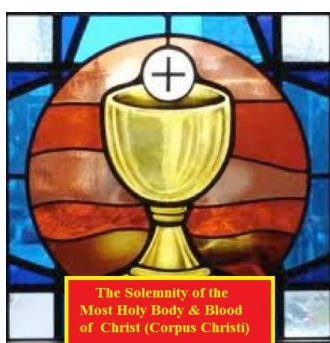
Liturgy in School

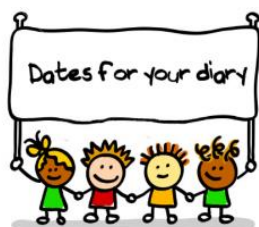
