Reading:

We will be giving your child a reading journal. We will write in it when your child reads with us at school. Please make sure your child has their book bag with their reading journal in school **everyday**.



We ask that children read regularly at home and that you record this in their journal. It is equally beneficial to read to your child and to record the books you have shared. Reading for pleasure is our main aim! Research shows that reading together for just **10 minutes a day** or several times a week has an incredibly positive impact on your child's confidence and achievement in life.

Volunteer Readers :

If you have any free hours then we are always on the lookout for volunteers to come and read with the children. Please speak to us if this is something you are interested in.

Homework:

Starting after Autumn half term.

Letter sounds and tricky words to be practised will be in your child's phonics home learning book. Occasionally we may send homework task sheets out or post activities to do on Tapestry. Home work can be uploaded to Tapestry or handed in on paper.
