Dear Friends

I just thought I should give you an update:

As of yesterday, I am working out my notice period. The council apparently made the decision in 2015 to stop funding the SCPs (School Crossing Patrollers) and are now just implementing that decision. Work will start across the borough to put in crossings at the affected school sites from the start of next week so that all these crossings will be in situ for the start of the school year in September.



Although the petition has been handed in and the total number of signatures collected was 1648 (therefore exceeding the required 1500 to force a debate in Chambers) the council are not due to meet again until July.

Whatever the outcome, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your absolutely amazing support.

I will keep you updated as and when I have any further information, but in the meantime, I'll keep doing what I do (with or without the Road Trolls)!!
