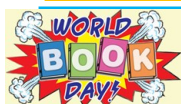

USING THE CAR PARK

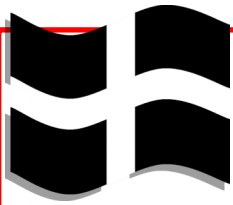
