### CAMERA CAR PATROL

There are 32 Leicestershire schools which camera car will patrol to issue £70 fines for illegal parking.

The new £500,000 enforcement campaign is underway to try to make the school run safer Leicestershire County Council says it will deploy the patrol vehicle outside schools it has identified as having a problem with motorists who ignore parking restrictions. The car will be appearing at dropping off and picking-up times to record vehicle registrations, track owners through the DVLA and issue £70 fines to offenders.

County Hall says it wants drivers to act considerately outside all of Leicestershire's schools to help keep pupils safe.

Brocks Hill Primary school is one of the 32 schools being patrolled.



If we run out of a specific book that you'd like, they can be ordered, however they must be paid for at the time of ordering. Thank you.




We have had some very kind and generous parents enquiring about how they can gift new books to their children's class libraries.
