## **LEICESTER CITY FOOTBALL CLUB TRAGEDY**

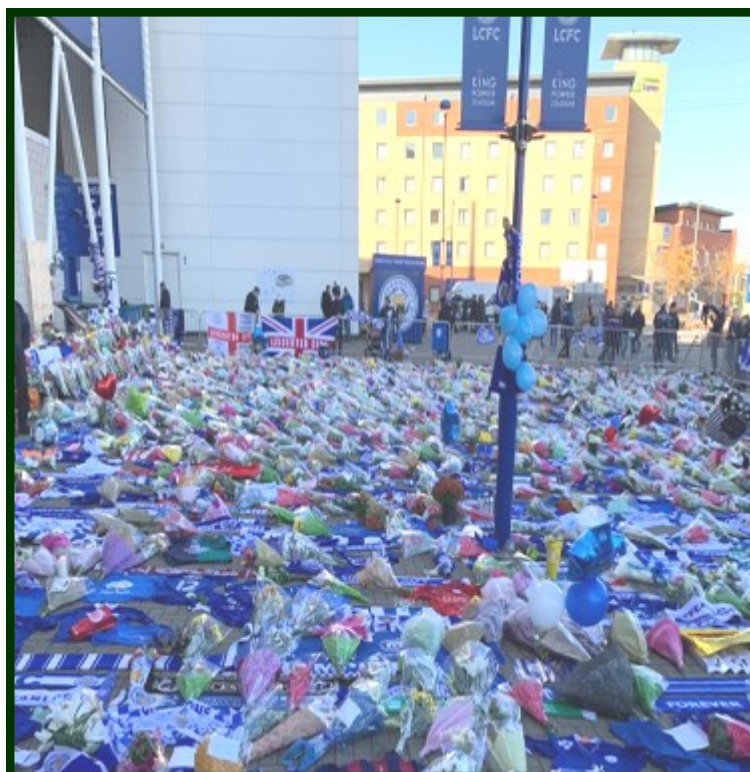
As you are all aware, the Leicester City Football Club lost their Chairman in a helicopter tragedy, which occurred last Saturday.
