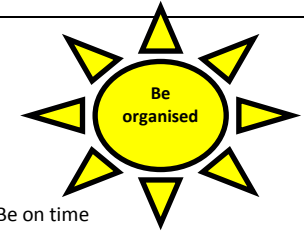
- Say kind things

- Be focused



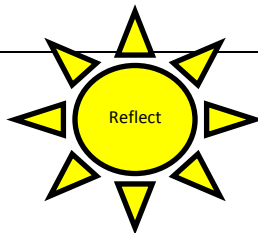
- Respect others

- Walk with your bike or scooter on the school site



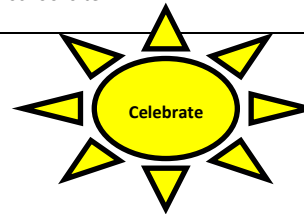
- Be on time

- Take important papers home in your reading folder



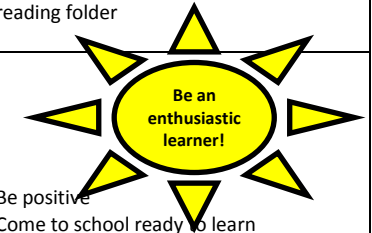
- Make good food choices
