Subject	Activity	Submission
Phonics 15 mins 	Please spend 5 - 10 minutes on Phonics Hero . Take a look at this week's Phonics PowerPoint. First practise the sounds you have already been taught, then the high frequency words. This week there are two words for you to learn to spell too. Look at how each of the sounds is made in the words before having a go at spelling them. Then have a go at sounding out and blending the words on the next slide (containing graphemes from previous lessons). Today we will learn an alternate spelling for 'n' - there is a slide with more information about this.	
English 45 mins	Handwriting - practise writing <i>one</i> and <i>eleven</i> . Remember all lower case letters start on the line! Non-Fiction Today you will explore the features of non-fiction books and identify ways that they are different to fiction books. You may have some non-fiction books at home that you could look at for this activity, or take a look at an ebook the Oxford Owl website . Perfect Pets, Our Class Tiger and Zoom Out are just a few examples of the non-fiction books you will find there. Have a go at sorting some books into 2 groups: fiction and non-fiction. Can you explain why you put each book in the group? Finally, take a look at the Monday English PowerPoint. Did you think of all of the features listed here?	
Maths 45 mins 	Please spend 5 - 10 minutes on Numbots OR select an activity from the maths warm up menu. Spring - Week 7 - Lesson 1 - Count in 2s Activity Watch and join in with the video. Afterwards, colour in the numbers to 50 on a 100 square that you would say if you were counting in 2s, starting from 2. Describe any patterns that you notice. Can you find objects at home that you could use to help you to practise counting in 2s? If you want an extra challenge try counting backwards in 2s as well.

English 45 mins	<p>Handwriting - practise writing two and twelve. Remember all lower case letters start on the line!</p> <p>Contents Page One of the features on a non-fiction book that you should have identified yesterday is the contents page. This is found at the front of the book and helps you to find the information you are looking for in the book. The heading of each section is listed in the order that they appear in the book, with the page number next to them.</p> <p>On the sheet Tuesday English you will find all of the part of a non-fiction book about toys. This includes the front cover, contents page, headings, captions and pictures. Can you cut them out and stick them in the correct places to make a short non-fiction book about toys? Make sure you use the contents page to help you to stick the pages in the correct order!</p>

<p>English 45 mins</p>	<p>Handwriting - practise writing three and thirteen. Remember all lower case letters start on the line!</p> <p>Index Page Hopefully when you were exploring non-fiction books on Monday you found that they often have an index page which is found at the back of the book. Take a look at an index page. Look at how the words are arranged. How could you use this to help you to find the information you were looking for in the book? You could ask whoever is helping you with your home learning to suggest something for you to look up in your non-fiction book. See how quickly you can find the information using the index page. This is much quicker than reading through the whole book!</p> <p>Can you make an index page for the book that you put together yesterday? Remember the words need to be in alphabetic order with the page number next to them.</p> <p>If you need a little more practise try putting the word cards (Wednesday English) in alphabetical order too.</p>

Finding Information Now that you are familiar with how to use a contents and index page it is time to have a go at using these to help you to find the answers to questions. Select a non-fiction book that you have at home and ask an adult to write you a list of questions to find the answers to. Remember to use the contents or index pages rather than reading through the whole book. The book doesn't have to be about toys.

Phonics 15 mins	Today you could play some phonics games. You may have some at home or you could make up your own. Here are some ideas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Play buried treasure by hiding words in sand or a box. - Put high frequency words on post-it notes around the house, these could be passwords to open doors or draws or be part of a word hunt. - Use chalk to write graphemes on the ground and spray them with water or jump on them when you hear them. - Play 'I-spy'. 	

<p>English/ Topic 45 mins</p>	<p>Handwriting - practise writing <i>five</i> and <i>fifteen</i>. Remember all lower case letters start on the line!</p> <p>Questions You already know lots about toys, particularly those that children today play with. I would like you to find out more about toys from the past. One way that we can learn more about the past is by asking questions. Today you will write a list of questions that you could ask your parents so that you can find out about their favourite toy that they played with when they were a child.</p> <p>Questions often start with the words when, where, why, who, what, how. They begin with a capital letter and end with a question mark.</p> <p>You might want to ask: <i>What was your favourite toy when you were a child?</i> Can you write at least 3 more questions that you would like to ask to find out more about the toy. You might want to know about the way it worked, the materials it was made from, the colour or other information too.</p>
