Friends Of Woodfield

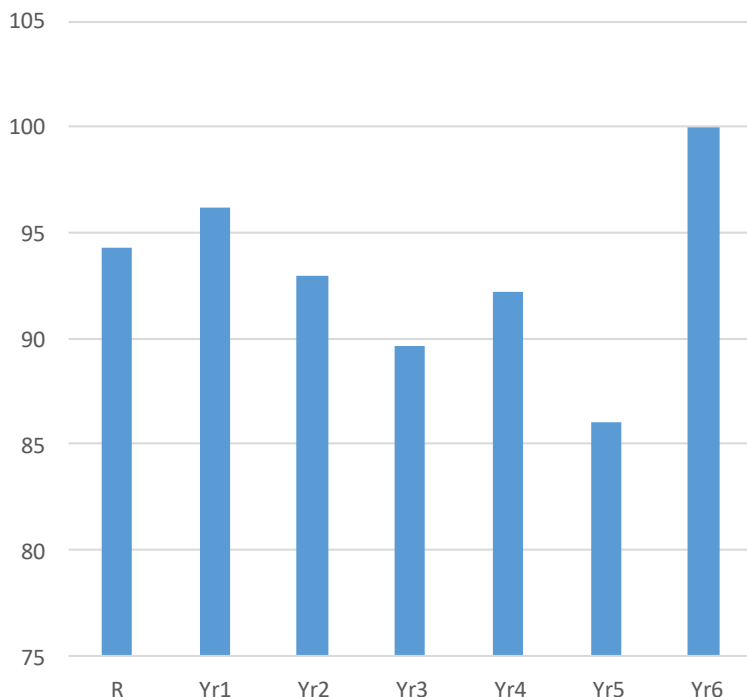


Come & join us on Wednesday 27th February for our second Friends of Woodfield meeting and enjoy a tea, coffee and biscuit as well as a friendly chat.
