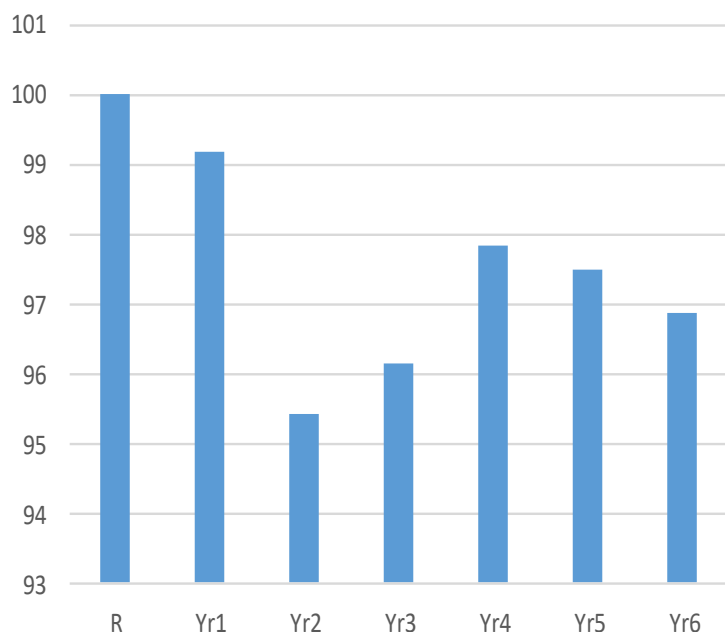
Learning Together
