Core Value - Honesty

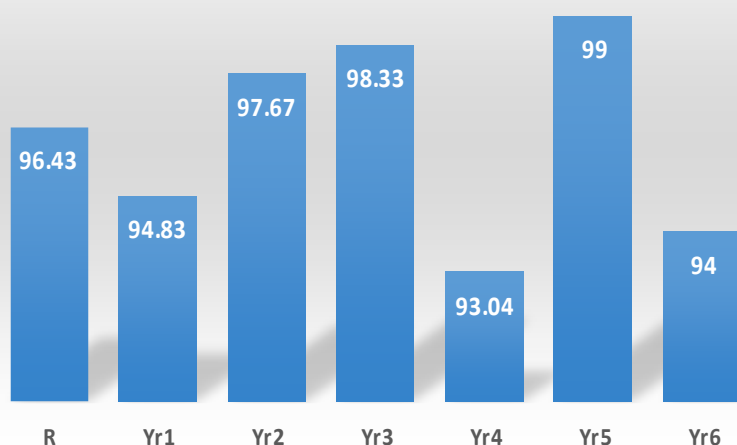


This month our core value is honesty and it will be the focus for some of our assemblies and discussions.
