**Nursery Parents' Evening** - Same dates as the school above. Please see your child's key worker between Tuesday 30 October & Friday 2 November to arrange a time.

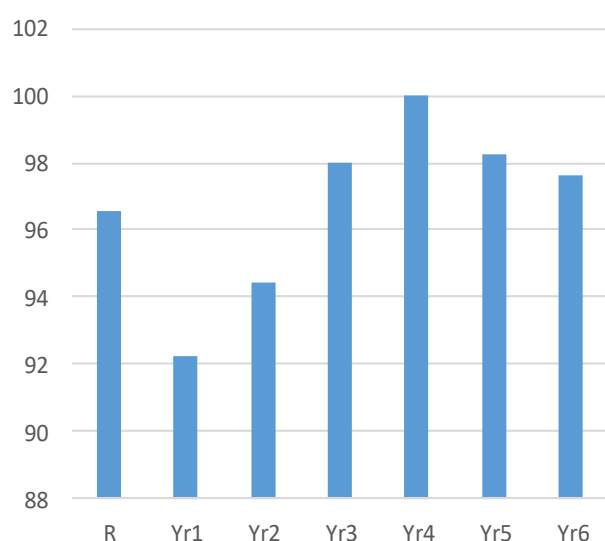
### Starting Primary School September 2019
