From Monday morning you will be able to book an appointment to see your child's teacher on the following dates:

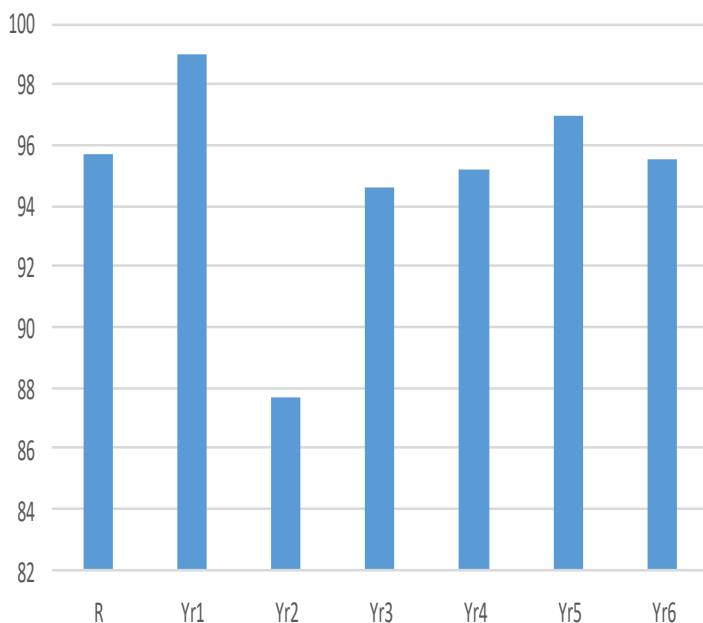
