### Ear-Rings / Hair Bows and Accessories

A reminder that children are not allowed to wear hooped ear rings in school. These ear rings are a huge risk whilst in school and can cause significant damage to a child's ear lobe if caught. Children can wear 1 pair of small studs. Any child seen wearing hooped ear rings will be asked to remove them and they will be held in the office until the end of the school day, parents will get a text to confirm this has happened. A reminder that hair bows should be small and along with any other hair accessories they must be only the colours of either blue, black or white, Thank you for your support in this matter.
