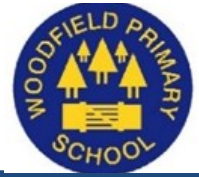

Run Fit Club



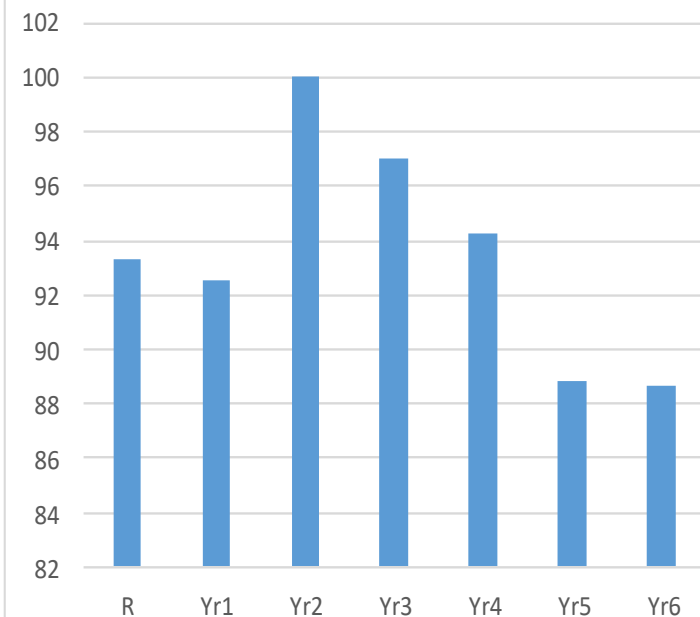
