## Overview of our week

This week we have been trying to follow the children's own interests. This has included writing about their favourite characters in the form of speech bubbles or an information or story book. It has also been economy week and we have been learning about money.

**Literacy:** In phonics we have started phase 4. We don't learn any new sounds, but we practise reading and writing words with adjacent consonants. This week, we were focusing on words that have two consonants at the end. When we are writing these it's really important to listen very carefully for both the consonant sounds.

**Maths:** We have been looking at money, especially coins! We have talked about the value of different coins and how they look different. We learnt that the golden coloured coins are worth more than the silver and bronze too.

We went on a money hunt and also set up a classroom shop for children to practise spending money.
