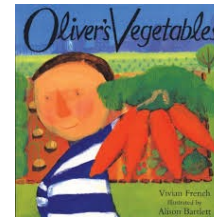
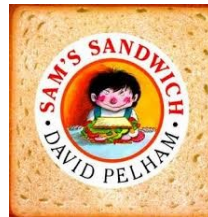
We welcome some new children to pre-school this term. They are settling well and all of the children are enjoying making new friends.

Don't forget to stick a new rhyme in their Songs & Rhymes book each week so you can enjoy these together too.

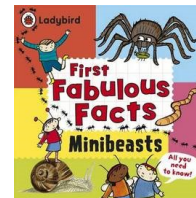
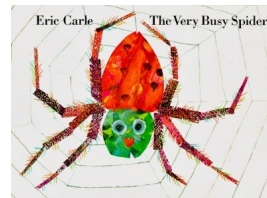
## TOPICS
