Size order some toys

At pre-school we'll be looking at the sizes of different dinosaurs. You can collect some objects, or dinosaurs if you have some, and talk about their sizes. Compare them to each other. Can you put them in size order? Which one is the biggest/smallest? Can find one that's smaller/bigger?

Practice counting

At pre-school, when we practice counting, we remember our 3 rules.

- 1 – If you can, line up the objects you want to count.
- 2 – Say number names in the right order, starting with 1.
- 3 – Say one number name for each item.

Collect a few toys and practice counting, using our three rules.

Take a look at some dinosaurs

Find some pictures of dinosaurs. Have a look at, and compare, their features. For example, do they all walk on 2 legs? Do they have feathers? Are their teeth pointy and sharp? What colours are they? Are they all the same size? Do they eat the same things? You can use books, a computer and the television to discover more about dinosaurs. Find out some facts and let us know!
