Please can you save any unwanted small boxes, tubes, pots and bottles from home and bring them to school for our junk modelling activities? All contributions are a big help. Thank you.

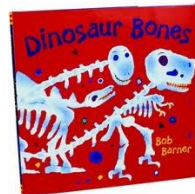


A warm welcome to the children and families who join us in pre-school this term.

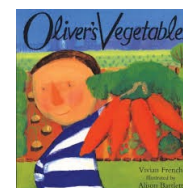
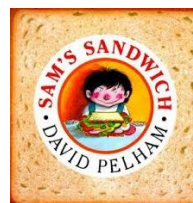
