History/ Geography

Welcome back after the holidays. I hope everyone has had a wonderful break and are ready to start a fabulous new year of learning. Our Class topic this term is "Anglo-Saxons and Vikings".

English

During this term the children will be working on a variety of reading and writing genre including, Fiction, Non-Fiction and Poetry. Children will be developing their spoken language, comprehension, composition, spelling and grammar skills. Children will be learning technical vocabulary and will be encouraged to use this when talking about their tasks and learning.

The children will continue to have daily Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar lessons (SPaG). We will be practising spelling strategies and looking at spelling rules to enhance their writing skills.

Maths

The children will be developing their skills within number & place value, addition & subtraction and multiplication & division during our maths lessons. Daily counting will take place to develop mental calculation skills and times tables. The children will be encouraged to use mathematical talk, reasoning and make connections between mathematical concepts. We will be developing formal written methods this year. Again, the children will be learning technical vocabulary and will be encouraged to use correct mathematical language.

Science

During Science, we will be learning about Forces and Magnets After half term we will be learning about sound.

The children will be taking part in explorations and investigations to make their own discoveries.

Computing

During our computing sessions we are thinking about e-safety. The children will be taught how to use search engines effectively and how to present their English and Art work digitally.

D&T/ Art

In art we will be practising and developing our Art skills. We will be concentrating on colour, pattern, shape and lines in our work. We will be designing, making and evaluating our own Viking helmets.

Your child will bring their reading book home every day and I would ask that where possible you could listen to them read. Spellings will be sent home each Thursday and will be tested the following Thursday. Homework will be sent out on a Friday and I would ask that this is returned by the following Wednesday, so it can be marked and new homework added. Any work that is sent home will be set according to your child's ability and your child should be able to complete this with limited support.
