4. Langar

Explain what is a langar meal is (Sikhism). Create your own langar meal recipe, you could even make your own meal and share with your family.

5. Be My Guest

Explain the message from the story 'Be my Guest' (Islam). Draw the people from the story and label how they were feeling during the story.

6. The Monkey King

Understand the different points of view in this story (Buddhism). Create a story map and think of questions you would ask the Monkey King.
