Caring for Others



Children should be able to:

2. Raksha Bandhan

3. The Good Samaritan

Explain the message of the Good Samaritan. Create a story map of this story from the Bible.

4. Langar

Explain what a langar meal is (Sikhism). Create your own langar meal recipe, you could even make your own meal and share with your family.

5. Be My Guest

Explain the message from the story 'Be my Guest' (Islam). Draw two of the people from the story and label how they were feeling during the story.

6. The Monkey King

Understand the different points of view in this story (Buddhism). Create a story map and think of one question you would ask the Monkey King.
