### Partial Reopening of Our School

Dear Parents/Carers

I would like to start this letter by saying a massive **thank you** for all of the support that you have shown during this time of National crisis. Your kind words, supportive emails and commitment to using our home learning resources has been incredible.

The team at Trenance are currently preparing to implement the Government's plan for schools to begin a phased reopening. As you will probably know Y2 pupils outside of the key worker and vulnerable category, **are not** included in the Government's plans for returning to school in June.

This is particularly heart breaking for our school as our Y2's are reaching the end of their time at Trenance and we had hoped to prioritise this year group. Please know that whilst we are unable to have Y2 back in school yet we are still fully committed to working with your children virtually and maintaining contact with them throughout this time.

### Home Learning and the Curriculum/Keeping in touch and Communication after Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020

Although we are unable to welcome our Year 2 pupils back to school at this time, the teaching team remain fully committed to working with your children virtually.

We will continue to suggest weekly activities based around our next topics, to keep you busy at home and will keep in contact with you through our Year 2 Facebook page, email address and website; we have loved seeing all of the wonderful things that you are doing at home and look forward to seeing what you do next! We will continue to respond to the work shared with us and look forward to speaking to you on the phone again soon to offer guidance, support or just to hear about the exciting things that you have been doing.

I want to reassure you that we are looking forward to being able to open to more of our pupils over the coming months if we are able to do so safely. We will, as always, communicate with you fully, openly and promptly as plans evolve and change as more information from the government becomes available.

### Transition to Newquay Junior Academy

Whilst we are currently unable to open Trenance to Y2 we are still thinking about their transition. We are continuing our communication with Newquay Junior Academy on arrangements and will let you know how this is to progress as soon as planned arrangements are finalised.
