

Department for Education vision for the Primary PE and Sports Premium:

All pupils leaving primary school are physically literate with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy, active lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.

The funding has been provided to ensure impact against the following objective:

To achieve self-sustaining improvement in the quality of PE and sport in primary schools. It is important to emphasise the focus of spending must lead to long lasting impact against the vision above that will live well beyond then Primary PE and Sports Premium Funding.

It is expected that schools will see an improvement against the following five indicators:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – kick-starting healthy active lifestyles. (It has been reported that the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity, 30 minutes of which should be in school)
2. The profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for a whole school improvement.
3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
4. Broader experiences of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
5. Increased participation in competitive sport.
