

PSHE

This term the children will be learning the topics Personal Safety and Working Together.

RE

This term we will be exploring the questions 'What kind of world did Jesus want? Followed by When Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost?'

PE

This term Year 4 will be developing their swimming skills whilst year 3 will be learning and practising tennis with a coach. In Indoor PE we will be doing Tri-Golf and Gymnastics.

Art / Design and Technology

During the Spring Term we will be recreating Roman designs in a mosaic. We will also be moulding clay pots.

Maths

This term the children will be continuing to develop their knowledge of multiplication and division. We will be further developing the children's knowledge of the times table facts.

The children will also be looking at what a fraction is and finding fractions of a whole.

We will also be continuing to allow the children opportunities to apply their knowledge to real life situations.



Year 3 and 4 Spring Term The Romans!

Topic

During this term we will be learning about The Romans and The Anglo Saxons. This will include The Roman Legacy and the evidence that still exists such as the sewers and the roads. We are also looking at life before and after the Romans and the impact on Britain of invaders and settlers.



MFL: French

This term they children will be re-visiting numbers and dates and practising how to use them in a variety of different ways.

Music

This term in music we are going to look at Roman instruments and the sort of music they played and when. We will use these ideas to compose some music in small groups. After half term we will be singing for the Easter service and concert.

Trips

Later on in the term we will be hosting a Roman day supported by Chatteris Museum. As part of the day the children will be indulging in a Roman feast.

Computing

This term we will be looking at e-safety and how to safely use emails, blogs and discussion boards. We will also be doing some programming.

English

We will be learning to write a range of different text types. These will all be linked to the topic and children will have opportunities to write their own myth, a historical story, instructional writing as well as a non-chronological report.

Science

We have two Science Topics this term: Rocks and Soils is our first topic where the children will become "Petrologists!" (Someone who studies rocks). We will also be studying plants part of which will involve actually growing some plants.
