<p>Statement about the effect of the expenditure on the educational attainment of those pupils who were eligible for pupil premium</p>	<p>The school will evaluate the impact on pupils eligible for Pupil Premium each term. Evaluation will focus on academic gains and how pupils' self-confidence develops as a consequence of the intervention.</p>

Outcomes

2016/17:

Year 1 Phonics Check

7 Year 1 children completed the Year 1 Phonics Check.

100% of the children passed their Year 1 Phonics Check.

3 children retook the Phonics Screening Check.

33% of the children passed their re-take.

End of Key Stage 1 achievement

8 children completed the end of Key Stage 1 tests.

75% reached the expected standard in Reading.

50% reached the expected standard in Writing.

50% reached the expected standard in Maths.

50% reached the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths.

13% achieved greater depth in Reading and Writing.

End of Key Stage 2 achievement

10 children completed the end of Key Stage 2 tests.

50% reached the expected standard in Reading.

40% reached the expected standard in Writing.

30% reached the expected standard in Maths.

30% reached the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths.

40% reached the expected standard in Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling

10% achieved greater depth in Reading & Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling
