Holiday action

1. **Reading.** Keep practising your reading over the holiday, read school books, books you have at home, join the library reading challenge, read information signs when you visit places, use Oxford Owls and Collins Connect online too.
2. **Phonics** Keep practising these skills too, the more you do the easier you will find reading and writing. Lots of lovely online games to play and you also have at least 50 different activities from previous signposts!
3. **Writing** It's important to not let this skill stop over the summer. Find real reasons for writing- shopping lists, postcards, treasure hunt clues for games for your family. Remember the handwriting letter families and try to practise this way of forming your letters.
4. **Number work** In Year One children will start recording their maths more often in written form so practising number formation would be a good skill to develop. Write the numbers on the beach in sand, in the garden with chalk or sticks, in the bath with bath crayons. It doesn't have to be on paper with a pencil!
5. **Most important have fun and keep safe.**
